INTRODUCTION

The third EU-China High Level Dialogue on Ocean affairs took place on 2 March 2017. Building on the positive results of the discussions held on ocean governance, blue growth and international ocean developments, both parties highlighted the opportunity to explore ways to reinforce EU-China cooperation on ocean affairs in the medium to long term.

The very first symbolic step in this direction is the launching of the 2017 EU-China Blue Year. As part of this EU-China Blue Year, a series of activities on ocean matters will be organized. These activities will aim to foster closer ties and mutual understanding by bringing together experts from both sides in different locations in China and Europe.

To this end, the two sides should step up the sharing of knowledge and the exchange of information, views, experiences and good practices by developing joint activities and participating in events such as conferences, meetings, workshops, seminars and study visits. In order to highlight this strengthened cooperation, the activities that are to take place throughout 2017 should be implemented as the "EU-China Blue Year". The possibility of reinforced cooperation beyond 2017 should also be explored.
